BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

In 2025, the Moreno Valley Unified School District (MVUSD) opened the Health & Wellness Center, further strengthening the community's network of supportive services and reinforcing a shared commitment to improving the quality of life for Moreno Valley residents. In coordination with the City's Business & Employment Resource Center (BERC), the partnership expands MVUSD families' access to essential workforce, career, health, and supportive services in a trusted, accessible community setting.

Through this collaboration, workforce development and career services offered through the BERC are extended to MVUSD families, providing residents with additional resources to pursue employment opportunities, strengthen job-readiness skills, and advance their career goals. By connecting families with both workforce and wraparound supportive services, the partnership helps address barriers that can affect economic stability, health, and overall well-being.
