Advisory Items

Partner Update – Moreno Valley Adult School

Stephanie Macias, Economic Development Business & Workforce Development Manager, introduced Elsa Magaña, Principal of Moreno Valley Community Adult School.

Dr. Magaña provided an overview of Moreno Valley Community Adult School and its mission to provide educational opportunities that prepare adult learners for college, career advancement, and lifelong success. She highlighted the school's High School Diploma, GED, English as a Second Language (ESL), Career Technical Education, Citizenship, and Computer programs, as well as its partnership with the City's Business & Employment Resource Center (BERC). Through this collaboration, students receive workforce resources, career support, referrals, and access to employment opportunities, helping strengthen workforce readiness and connect residents with educational and career pathways.

Business & Employment Resource Center (BERC) – April 2026 Monthly Report

Stephanie Macias, Economic Development Business & Workforce Development Manager, presented a comprehensive update on workshops, statistics on residents and veterans served via phone or one-on-one meetings, job fairs, and educational opportunities offered through the BERC, as well as updates on current partnerships and upcoming events.

The highlights included a range of signature workshops and partner events, as well as hiring information events hosted by Solaris Paper, and IHSS where 166 available jobs were available. Additionally, career coaching and partner sessions were held, serving 20 customers through Riverside Legal Aid, 94 customers through the Employment Development Department, and 133 customers who received career coaching. Over 300 new customers were added to the job seeker list, 135 new members were added to the MoVal Veterans list, and 267 were added to the Small Business list. Staff continues their focus on marketing through social media. Metrics for the job seeker list and event attendees were shared, along with a calendar of upcoming events.

Melissa McClain, Economic Development Manager, provided a detailed update on recent growth in the commercial and industrial sectors, as well as on developments in office space, both completed and currently in progress, as of June 2026. Highlights included the Tiny Toes Play Café, Gordo's Cafecito, Jimmy's Smokey Pit BBQ, and Sky Zone opening their doors on June 19, 2026.
